PROJECT GUIDELINES

- **Choose 2-5 High School Graduates** in your neighborhood to send a Card Bundle (5-10 Cards) to.
 - <u>Option</u>: To easily find graduates in your neighborhood, scout out the homes with Graduation Yard Signs on them.
- **Download** the Invite Letter to distribute. You can make your own, but please make sure you include the Card Guidelines. A word doc version is avialable on ACTIONvc.org/resources.
- **Distribute** the Invite letter to your street/neighborhood between June 1st- 5th. (Skip the homes that the letters are going to- you want it to be a surprise!) There are many ways to spread the word:
 - <u>Print the letter and put it in mailboxes</u>: The more people you get to participate- the more cards you can send out!
 - Email the letter. Use the Social Media Invite Letter.
 - <u>Post the letter</u> on Social Media/ Next Door app. You will have to download the Next Door app (if you don't have it already) but this a great way to get the word out while remaining in your direct neighborhood!
- Make your batch of cards. Please make at least 3-5 cards. Better yet, get your family involved and make even more! Please follow the Card Guidelines below.
- **Collect cards by June 10th.** That way, you can have a day to organize and bundle the cards for each grad. Again, please make sure every graduate you choose gets at least 5-10 cards.
- Add the double-sided Bundle Cover to each group of cards.
- Drop off cards on June 12th- that's the day of graduation!
