### **ABOUT ACTION VC**

#### WHO IS ACTION VC?

ACTION VC is a volunteer coordinating agency serving under-resourced seniors and vulnerable families with critical needs since 2006.

#### WHAT DOES ACTION VC DO?

ACTION VC connects local volunteers to our neighbors by meeting critical needs that restore the safety and improve their quality of life. ACTION VC offers a variety of programs including Community Christmas Shoppe, Love VC, Local Love Days, NOW Projects, Accessibility Projects, and Emergency Services.

#### WHERE DOES ACTION VC WORK?

ACTION VC volunteers serve residents in Ventura County. Service projects take place at individual homes, local agencies, churches and schools.

#### WHEN WILL THE WORK BE DONE?

ACTION VC volunteers work with the client to create their own schedule of service. Volunteers serve when they can, with respect for the personal schedule of those being served. Many volunteers prefer to serve with their friends and family on the weekends.

### **HOW DO WE DO IT?**

100% volunteer labor. With nearly 4,000 volunteers, ACTION VC serves over 14,000 people every year. Projects are funded through grants and the generosity of individual donors.

### WHY DOES ACTION VC SERVE?

We hope to see neighbors connected, relationships restored, and communities inspired in Ventura County and beyond!



### **ACTION VC PROGRAMS**



**COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS SHOPPE** → Community Christmas Shoppe is a fun and festive event that serves under-resourced families by providing toys for Christmas. We partner with local schools and social service agencies to find families otherwise unable to afford Christmas presents for their children, and invite them to "shop" for toys at no cost.



**LOVE VC** → Love VC is an annual event that brings acts of service to under-served communities across Ventura County. On one day in June, thousands of volunteers complete hundreds of large-scale projects to meet critical needs for low income neighborhoods and community organizations.



**LOCAL LOVE DAYS** → Local Love Days are mini "Love VC" days that help businesses, small groups, and schools give back to their cities through smaller, but specifically tailored, projects. Local Love Day projects focus on improving neighborhoods and connecting neighbors within their communities!



**NOW PROJECTS (NEEDS OF THE WEEK)** → Needs of the Week serves under-resourced seniors, families, and those with disabilities by meeting critical minor home repair needs that restore their safety and improve their quality of life.



**ACCESSIBILITY PROJECTS** • Accessibility Projects serve low income and handicapped individuals by meeting critical mobility needs to restore independence in the home. By using skilled contractors and handymen, we complete wheelchair ramp, grab bar, stair modification, handrails and door widening projects.



**EMERGENCY SERVICES** → Currently, our COVID-19 services provide essential help to those who can't leave their homes due to health concerns, and don't have family or neighbors around to help them. We focus on bringing phone companionship to those living in isolation, picking up and delivering of groceries for the immunocompromised, and providing care packages for those who are unable to make ends meet.

ACTION VC donates over 20,000 hours of volunteer labor in the community every year.

This donation of time and talents is possible solely through the generosity and dedication of nearly 4,000 volunteers. Every time an ACTION VC volunteer visits with a lonely senior or completes a small home repair, they display acts of service and embody a community that cares for their own. They are actively participating in the movement of serving our community- one neighbor at a time. ### **WHO WE SERVE**

- 1. **UNDER-RESOURCED SENIORS** Low income, often isolated / disabled
- 2. **<u>VULNERABLE FAMILIES</u>** Low-income, disabled/special needs, and single parents
- 3. **NEIGHBORHOODS** Under-served and under-resourced

With approximately 150,000 seniors, and over 1,000 foster children currently residing in Ventura County, the goal of ACTION VC programs is to strategically connect volunteers with the individuals and families of those who need the most help.

Numerous county agencies, hospital social workers, in-home caregivers, and other non-profits request volunteers from ACTION VC every day. ACTION VC responds by donating valuable time and talents to serve people in need. The generosity of ACTION VC volunteers impacts the lives of over 14,000 Ventura County residents every year.

## **CONFIDENTIALITY**

#### WE ASK ALL VOLUNTEERS TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

**DO:** Obtain consent for collecting, using and disclosing personal information, except when appropriate (for example, in an emergency). The ACTION VC Liability Release Form can be signed to obtain written consent from each person serving and/or receiving volunteer services.

**DO:** Use and disclose personal information only for the purposes for which it was collected (for example, Name, address, primary contact phone number to arrange the service project.) ACTION VC retains this information only to connect volunteers with the people they serve.

**DO:** Ensure that all information obtained remains SECURE, and is kept only until the completion of the service project.

DO NOT: Ask overly personal questions (for example, the person's age, income, work status, family structure or personal history). These questions may be viewed as INTRUSIVE and are not required to complete the volunteering experience.

Please be considerate of others emotions and privacy.



## **EMERGENCY INFORMATION**

# IF YOU ENCOUNTER A SERIOUS EMERGENCY OR BODILY INJURY, CALL 911.

Locations of local hospitals and urgent care facilities near your service location can be obtained through personal online search prior to visiting your service site. Please be aware of your surroundings and take necessary steps to ensure the safety of your person, fellow volunteers and any other individuals nearby.



## **MINORS AS VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteers under the age of 18 who wish to participate in volunteer service *must have a signed written consent letter or liability form of a parent or legal guardian before they may begin service.* The volunteer tasks assigned to a minor shall be limited to age appropriate activities and will be performed solely at the discretion and responsibility of the parent or legal guardian. Additionally, *the parent or legal guardian is required to be present with the minor throughout the duration of the service project.* 

# **VEHICLE REGULATIONS/PARKING**



ACTION VC does not require the use of personal vehicles for the transport of passengers or goods. Use of personal vehicles in the performance of volunteer service is entirely at the liability and risk of the vehicle owner and operator. All California Department of Motor Vehicle laws and regulations apply.

## **VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT**

# ALL PERSONS VOLUNTEERING WITH ACTION VC ARE EXPECTED TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS REGARDING PERSONAL CONDUCT:

- I will take my commitment to serve seriously and perform to the best of my abilities. Be prepared and bring any necessary materials for your service project. Don't forget to take a break and stay hydrated!
- I will respect the mission and vision of ACTION VC while serving the community.
- I will follow through on commitments I have made and will promptly inform ACTION VC. if I am unable to serve as scheduled.
- I will obey and follow all local and federal laws.

  Alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited while volunteering with ACTION VC.
- I will respect the property of the individual.
- I will be courteous, friendly and cooperative with ALL volunteers.
- I will deal with conflict or difficulties in an appropriate manner.

  It is okay to say "no" while volunteering. You may be asked to do additional projects for the person you are serving- DO NOT do work you are not comfortable with. Politely say, "I am not able to do that" and/or recommend that the person call ACTION VC to request additional projects.
- I will offer constructive feedback about ACTION VC, my group, my organization, my church, and the persons served in an appropriate manner.

  Please let ACTION VC know if you encounter an issue with the person you are serving or have concerns about the service project that you selected.
- I will demonstrate respect for the direction and decisions of ACTION VC, my group, my organization, my church, the persons served.
- I will treat ACTION VC staff, my fellow volunteers, people served and members of the public fairly and without discrimination.
- I will <u>not</u> accept valuable gifts/money from those served. (Please send donations to the ACTION VC office)

Note: This list is not exhaustive and may not cover every situation or provide you with a set of absolute standards. Please seek clarification from ACTION VC staff as needed.

### **LOCAL LOVE DAYS**

Local Love Days Local Love Days are mini "Love VC" days that help businesses, small groups, and schools give back to their cities through smaller, but specifically tailored, projects. Local Love Day projects focus on improving neighborhoods and connecting neighbors within their communities!

Do you have a group of 10 or more people who would love to make a difference in your local community? Sign up for a Local Love Day!

#### **HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:**

- 1. Contact ACTION VC's Project Coordinator about your interest in a Local Love Day.
- 2. Depending on what city your group is in, the location of the project may vary (i.e. Mobile Home Parks, Local Schools, Churches, etc.)
- 3. Decide on a date and time that works best for your group (Weekends work best for most).
- 4. ACTION VC's Project Coordinator will help you decide what kinds of projects would work best for your group (i.e. Yard Work, Painting, Window Washing).
- 5. Choose someone in your group who will be the Project Leader and person of contact.
- 6. ACTION VC will coordinate projects with the clients at the project site and send the group's project leader all the project details.
- 7. Gather the materials needed for the project.
- 8. The day of the project, your group will show up at the assigned time and complete the list of projects provided by ACTION VC. Your group leader will connect with the liaison for the Mobile Home Park, School, etc. and let them know that you are there and ready to work!
- 9. After your group's Local Love Day, the project leader of your group will connect with ACTION VC's Project Coordinator and provide feedback as to how the Local Love Day went!
- 10. Tell others about the Local Love Day you participated in, and plan to participate in another one!
