STRATEGIC STEWARDSHIP

On average, we put \$800,000 back into Ventura County through donated toys, project materials, and volunteer labor, which is 4X our annual budget! Every dollar - from programs to admin - is used critically to further our impact.



AUTHENTIC AWARENESS

When we take part in service projects for our neighbors on the margins, we increase our awareness of the social and economic disparities within our cities. This awareness enables us to help our communities heal, grow, and thrive.



CONNECTED COMMUNITY

We believe all systems within our community need to work together to create holistic care for the most vulnerable in Ventura County. That's why we work to unite schools, businesses, churches, and agencies in serving our neighbors.



SUSTAINABLE SERVICE

We provide tangible service projects that improve the quality of life and home safety for those in financial, physical, and spiritual need. And spending time to meet a repair need for a neighbor reminds them that they are cared for and loved!



2021 Insight

What does it mean to stand with the most vulnerable in our communities?

We meet tangible needs for our neighbors in need - those with few or no resources available to them.

Seniors, veterans, those with disabilities, and those living in poverty make up a disproportionate amount of our population.

We believe we can change these statistics by fostering a community of neighbors that take care of one another.

OUR COMMUNITY, OUR WORK

LOW-INCOME SENIORS

Seniors 65+ are the fastest-growing demographic in Ventura County, and 8% live below the poverty level.

By meeting their critical repair needs, we keep our seniors safe in their homes and create restorative relationships within the neighborhood.

PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Almost a third of Ventura County's population are people living with disabilities, and persons with a disability are more likely to live in poverty in comparison to their neighbors. We meet accessibility needs at no cost to our neighbors so that they can remain independent and safe at home.

VULNERABLE FAMILIES

Many families are at risk of being stuck in the cycle of poverty. Some live paycheck to paycheck but do not qualify for benefits or have been impacted by a loss, and now parent alone. When our volunteers connect to these families, we meet spiritual needs as well as physical ones.

UNDERSERVED COMMUNITIES

Economic disparity and invisible poverty exist within our County - but these issues are deeply pervasive in underserved cities. We have found that by linking arms with the churches, agencies, schools, and businesses already serving these neighborhoods, we combine our efforts and deepen our impact.



GLORIA'S STORY

NO NEIGHBOR SHOULD SUFFER JUST BECAUSE THEY CAN'T AFFORD THE HELP.

For 5 years, Gloria struggled to get in and out of her mobile home because of the steep stairs. But living alone on social security, she couldn't afford services that would keep her safe at home.

In April of 2021, Gloria fell and broke her hip trying to navigate the stairs outside her home. While in the hospital healing from surgery, our team built Gloria an ADA wheelchair ramp so she could heal without any more fears of falling or being isolated in her home!

Today, she is happy because she knows she is safe.

Together, we are building a more accessible Ventura County.


Year to date, we have completed 37 accessibility projects (11 ramps, 10 stair builds/modifications, 14 grab bars, 2 flooring repairs)

THIS IS A 106% INCREASE OVER PROJECTS COMPLETED IN 2020.



ACCESSIBILITY PROJECTS COMPLETED 2015 - 2021




NOW PROJECTS COMPLETED 2021



WHAT'S AHEAD

OUR 2022 GOALS

- To have 3 accessibility teams that can complete 2-3 projects a month for those with disabilities. This will help us keep up with the demand for wheelchair ramps, grab bars, and stair modifications,
- To expand our 2022 Christmas Shoppes to serve an additional 500+ families that have been impacted by the pandemic and the affordable housing crisis in Ventura County.
- To further partner with professional cleaning services and environment hazard companies so we can meet urgent and critical needs for seniors that want to age safely in their homes.
- To join forces with 10 new partners that will work with us to deepen our impact in underserved neighborhoods.




