2023 Objectives

This year we are focusing on 6 key areas and taking steps towards achieving these objectives.



STRENGTHENING PARTNERS

Helping churches, businesses, and community groups identify needs in their community and provide insight, coordination, and turn-key projects.

MOBILIZING VOLUNTEERS

ENGAGING COMMUNITIES

Forging new relationships with community leaders to remain on the cutting edge of emerging trends and ways we can help.

- Began a pilot project to meet with city officials. Have met with with the mayor, police chief, housing director, senior services department of Oxnard City.
- We met with county and local officials including supervisors, code enforcement, and homelessness task force.



MEETING NEEDS

Ensuring that people from all walks of life receive care that helps them feel safer, more connected, and empowered to thrive.

- Translated our materials into Spanish.
- Created a tool for volunteers to stay connected with neighbors they served and provide future help.
- Presented at senior centers and service clubs on how to request services.



RELEASING GENEROSITY

Investing resources back into our communities.

- Now offer planned giving strategies to make the most of legacy gifts.
- Provide more ways to invest in our mission and working with new grant partners to release resources.



ALIGNING OPERATIONS

Maximizing low overhead for high impact while caring for our staff and adjusting procedures for the greatest effectiveness.

- Held our first Annual Meeting Breakfast since the pandemic.
- We invested in our staff to retain top talent and added an additional part-time communications coordinator position.
- Welcomed student interns from CSUCI to assist office operations.


Program Stats

Our network of amazing volunteers selflessly gives their time and talent. Their effort goes beyond just meeting needs, they build relationships and impact lives. Here's a sample of how ACTION VC programs have served and connected our communities so far in 2023.



Budget

We strive for the highest standard of stewardship so that every penny donated to ACTION VC creates the greatest impact in the communities we love and serve. So far this year, we have put over \$58,000 worth of volunteer labor and project materials back into our neighborhoods. Here's how we allocated this year's \$393,500 budget.

Both Tom and his late sister were born with Primary Ciliary Dyskinesia, a genetic condition that causes complications with the lungs, ears, and sinuses. Between medical expenses and work limitations, it has been difficult to remain in a stable living condition. There were seasons where he lived in his car to make ends meet.

"The ripple effect is hard to see," said Tom discussing how health concerns and financial distress compound. "It snowballs and it can be difficult to reestablish yourself, even when you have your health. When you don't, you're lying to yourself by saying you can do this, you can get by on your own. It doesn't mean you're a failure. It just means you need help. But there's always hope."

Ultimately in need of a lung transplant, he struggles to exert himself. He reached out to ACTION VC because his yard was overgrown and he couldn't tackle it himself. Through our Needs of the Week (NOW) Program, he was matched with a couple who was able to help him out.

"This is a good program," Tom said.
"What made a difference for me was a phone call to ACTION VC led to two people coming over to my house and involving themselves in my world for a bit. And that's the beauty of it. ACTION reaches out. I was having a difficult time and then two strangers came in and helped. It meant a lot to have that human touch."
